- Will the Mud Brook Trail Phase 2 project include suggestions from the public on how to create a better Trail for Cuyahoga Falls residents and visitors?
- Will the City of Cuyahoga Falls make efforts to contact churches to inform them of ways to apply for the [Community Development Block Grant](#) carryover funds, so the

churches and ministries can help provide affordable housing for families and financially disadvantaged people?

- The City of Cuyahoga Falls held its city council meeting on Feb. 9 at the Cuyahoga Falls Natatorium. Six ordinances and resolutions were presented. The new ordinances and resolutions will address resurfacing and pavement preservation on various streets within the city.

There will also be an ordinance authorizing the Park and Recreation Board to enter into a contract(s), without competitive bidding, with [Site Technology Inc.](#), for the repairs to the [Cuyahoga Falls High School](#) tennis courts.
